Kit List

Bring plenty of clothes and a plastic bag for wet and muddy clothing. We are staying for **five days and four nights**. Each day we do four different activities so be prepared to change between activities and make sure you bring enough clothing.

A bag/suitcase containing:

- Swimwear and quick drying clothes to go over the top, such as t-shirt and shorts
- Appropriate clothing for outdoor activities, suitable for the weather. We recommend bringing old clothes that can get wet and muddy! We have a heated drying room for clothes to dry overnight.
- Some activities require trousers and a long sleeve top regardless of the weather.
- A lightweight waterproof jacket may be advisable if the weather is not so good.
- A sun hat and sun cream is recommended if it turns out to be warm and sunny in July!
- At least two pairs of shoes, one for dry activities and one for wet activities. Students usually bring an old pair of trainers or wet shoes for wet activities. They must not be open-toe.
- Underwear
- Socks (bring spares in case they get wet!)
- Nightwear
- A wash bag (soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo, shower gel, deodorant etc) and at least two towels.
- Any medication needed for the week. This must be handed to a member of staff with the clear written instructions attached.

Kit List

- A sleeping bag and a pillow. Students will be sleeping in bunk beds with a mattress.

A bag/suitcase containing:

- Swimwear and quick drying clothes to go over the top, such as t-shirt and shorts
- Appropriate clothing for outdoor activities, suitable for the weather. We recommend bringing old clothes that can get wet and muddy!
- Some activities require trousers and a long sleeve top regardless of the weather.
- A lightweight waterproof jacket may be advisable if the weather is not so good.
- A sun hat and sun cream is recommended if it turns out to be warm and sunny in July!
- At least two pairs of shoes, one for dry activities and one for wet activities. Students usually bring an old pair of trainers or wet shoes for wet activities. They must not be open-toe.
