This is one of the reasons we need a safer internet because people are spreading fake news on things such as the coronavirus being fake and the vaccine isn't real






Donald Trump the former president of the united states told the Americans to inject a cleaning product into themselves to stop the spread of coronavirus! Which was of course fake news.
