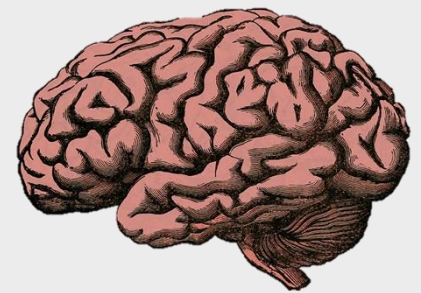


Welcome to Highams Park School!

Psychology (A-Level)

Psychology is the scientific study of the mind and behaviour. Our A-Level course offers a deep dive into fascinating topics such as memory, attachment, social influence, psychopathology and biopsychology. Students will also develop research and analytical skills by conducting psychological investigations.



Sociology (GCSE & A-Level)
